#### Attendance Matters!

- Academics
- Social skills
- PREP FOR HIGH SCHOOL!!!
- On track = 93% or above
- Off track = your student is missing 10% or more of school
  - This is 12 total days missed
  - This is about 2 days a month.
- ON TRACK with attendance means you get to participate in our **ON TRACK celebrations**.
  - It also means 8th graders are one step closer to Continuation.



### What counts AGAINST my student's attendance?

- Even if you call BVMS and inform us your student will be gone, that counts against their attendance (this is the same at all schools)
- Tardy = missed time in class = counts against your attendance
- Off track in attendance means you...
  - Cannot participate in our "On Track" celebrations.
  - Cannot walk the stage at 8th Grade Continuation
  - Very low attendance may mean NO sports.

We can't do our job to get to your know student, build that relationship with your amazing kid, and GROW them if they aren't here.

## **New Grading Policy**

Grading expectations at BVMS have shifted for the 25-26 school year to support student learning and attendance. There is a grading policy one pager with in-depth information in your packet. Please review it with your student.

#### **New Grading Policy Highlights:**

- Deadline for late work is the end of each Unit (the day of unit test)
- Students may correct work to earn back only ONE letter grade
  - Example: D to C or B to A
- Classwork and tests must be made up when a student is absent
- Incomplete work will earn a grade of 0 until it is turned in
- Unexcused tardies to class will result in a loss of points on Do Now assignments as those happen in the beginning of class.
- Monthly progress reports will be emailed home but student grades can be monitored regularly in Schoology

## **Schoolwide Expectations**

At Bear Valley, we expect all students to uphold the following expectations:

- 1. 93% attendance or higher
- 2. C's or better in all classes
- 3. On track iCAP
- 4. No major or repeated behavior issues
- ★ Families will receive a monthly progress report from their student's LC mentor informing them on their student's current progress
- ★ These expectations are directly tied to student's eligibility to attend quarterly celebrations.
- ★ For 8th graders, these are also the eligibility requirements to participate in continuation week activities in May!
- ★ ONLY ON TRACK STUDENTS WALK THE STAGE @ CONTINUATION!!!

## Bear Valley Dress Code

#### ALLOWED!

Hats & beanies!

TO DEVELOP COMM**UNITY** AND YETI PRIDE, WE EXPECT OUR STUDENTS TO UPHOLD THESE EXPECTATIONS EVERYDAY!

- Pants, shorts, & skirts can be worn in any color/style but must:
  - Cover legs with no rips or shreds above the mid-thigh
  - Shorts & skirts must be at or below fingertips with arms at sides

#### NOT ALLOWED!

- · Sunglasses inside school building
- Any article of clothing promoting drugs, alcohol, violence, discrimination, sexual innuendo, derogatory language, gangs, or any illegal activity

#### Shirts & Outerwear

- All tops must be one of the 5 approved colors of black, any shade of blue, any shade of grey, white or any shade of green.
- Tops must be plain (no stripes or color blocking) and free of logos unless the ONE logo on the shirt can be covered by a 3in\*3in square (i.e. Nike Swoosh, Addidas logo)
- Shirts all must have straps that are at least
   3 fingers wide (no thin straps or tube tops)
- BVIS logo'd t-shirts and hoodies from previous years are welcomed!

## HOODIES

Jackets, pull-over or zip-up hoodies in the 5 color wheel are allowed, but hood must be off heads at all times inside the buiding

Shirts under outerwear must be in the FIVE color wheel

- No house slippers
- No blankets

- No bellies!
  - No crop tops
- No butts!
  - No sagging

## **Phones & Airpods**

#### We are N

- - We feel strongly about your student's academic and mental well being, and we ask for your partnership in student's NOT having phones in class.
- Cre 1st incident of phone or airpods in class = Phone given to Principal and locked in drawer. Student gets at the end of the day.

2nd incident = Phone given to Principal and parent needs to get at the end of the day.

## ISS, Lunch Detention, & Lunch Repair

#### An opportunity to take accountability and repair harm!









- Lunch Repair: Lunch and/or Recess with a teacher to connect and repair.
  - You will be notified by your students teacher the day before if your student has been assigned ISS or lunch repair for the following day(s). Off track behavior in class/0 or 1 on yeti watch
- Lunch Detention: Lunch detention is only assigned when a student is caught in a hall sweep(tardy to class)
  - You will be notified by RCT the day before your student serves lunch detention.
- There are no more half days or "PASS" this year. We are going into full days of In School Suspension(ISS) for major safety incidents and the following..
  - <u>3</u> Dial zeros in a quarter
  - o <u>3</u> Tardies in a quarter
  - o <u>3</u>Dress Code offenses a quarter
  - <u>3</u> Cell Phone/airpod offenses a quarter
  - Not passing yeti watch phases
