# **Projections**

### **25-26 District Projections**

6th: 100 7th: 88 8th: 92

Total: 280

#### 25-26 BVMS Actual

6th: 113 (+13)

7th: 98 (+10)

8th: 101 (+9)

Total: 312 (+32)

#### **26-27 District Projections**

6th: 108 7th: 105 8th: 90

Total: 303 (-9)

#### **26-27 BVMS Projected Ranges**

6th: 108-114 7th: 105-114 8th: 90-100

Total: 303 to 328 (-9 to +16)

# **Projection Impacts**

- A funding level of 303 students is down 9 students from now
  - This represents a loss of ~\$120,000
- We are also losing ~\$175,000 in tiered supports money
- There is a small negative impact from annual employee salary increases and potentially larger state funding decrease (unknown)
- The combined loss at face value is just shy of \$300k
- Our reserves are healthy at over \$250k currently

# **Projection Impacts**

### However...

- This year we were funded at 280 students but ended up 32 students higher
- We received only about half the funding we would normally receive for those 32 students

### Based on what we know now...

- 303 students means budget deficit of \$100k (could be covered from reserves
- 316 students means a slight budget surplus ~\$40k



### MIS #1 - Attendance


- Current OA Data: 90.1% (last year 86.9)
- Tardy Data:
  - 2,312 All periods 24-25;1,113 25-26 Reduction39.96%
- Tardy Data no P1:
  - 1,175 24-25; 393 25-26 Reduction 64.64%

- Chronic Attendance (CA) Target: 36%

# Where are we? (9/15 - 10/20)

## Cycle 1

Outreach phone calls have had one of two effects:

- 1. A **positive** effect, resulting in improved attendance
- 2. **Little to no effect**, with attendance remaining the **same** or **worsening**

As of the 10/20 data pull, new students have emerged as attendance concerns.


