Interim #1

Interim tests are standardized district tests that help us get benchmark on student progress ahead of CMAS

- ◆ Math (all grade)
- ◆ Literacy (all grades)
Social Studies (7th Grade only)
- ◆ Science (8th Grade only)

We run a testing schedule, assign all students their accommodations, and raffle off prizes (snacks, free dress, gift cards)

Interim #1

Our goal is 95% or higher participation for each test/grade

- ◆ 6th Grade: ~5
- ◆ 7th Grade: ~6
- ◆ 8th Grade: ~9

We will be completing make ups prior to 10/31 PD Day when teachers will be analyzing the data and making action plans for reteaching key standards.



Budget Updates: Hiring

We are fully staffed currently except for:

- LTS for 7th grade math intervention (end Q2)
- LTS for Mild Mod SPED (some district float support)

Position Changes:

- RCT Para hired and working ISS!
 - Replacement mild mod para hired for a 1:1 student
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Budget Updates: Tiered Supports

Our district tiered supports are fading out as planned:

- 25-26 (this year): \$285k
- 26-27 (next year): \$110k
- 27-28: ~\$35k
- 28-29: \$0

Budget Updates: Enrollment

Funding Based on Enrollment (+33)

- Largest grade is 6th grade
- 25-26: 33 students x \$6685 = \$220,605
- 26-27: 33 students x ~\$12k = \$396,000
- If we maintain our 6th graders and repeat similar enrollment we would increase about 10 more students
 - This would be an additional \$120k based on current data

SLT Updates

3 Strikes Policy

- SLT voted on update to 3 strikes policy for dial zeros
- Starts back over at 1 after 3
- Allows intervention to happen at intermediate steps to support keeping students out of ISS
