

Questions from our families

Q: When will students return to the building if they choose the in-person path?

A: We will have a staggered start

- ★ Wednesday, October 21st - 6th Grade
- ★ Thursday, October 22nd - 7th Grade, 6th Grade
- ★ Friday, October 23rd - 8th Grade, 7th Grade, 6th Grade

Q: What time is school?

A: We will be following the same [bell schedule](#) we have used remotely thus far this year!

The earliest that scholars can arrive on campus at 8:15am

Each grade level will have their own unique entrance doors to honor social distancing

FREE grab-n-go breakfast will be offered to all scholars

Health screening will be conducted prior to entering the building

Scholars will line up by their specific cohort

They will enter with a their Block 1 teacher and go directly to the classroom

They will remain in this classroom all day, minus bathroom and handwashing breaks.

Lunch will be held in classrooms

As weather permits go outside for lunch and social distant, mask breaks

Scholars will be dismissed at 1:15pm to return home to participate in:

- ★ Independent reading
- ★ IXL
- ★ Class assignments
- ★ Tutoring/Office Hours

Q: Are DPS Yellow busses available?

A: No, unfortunately due to capacity constraints with CDC social distancing rules, busses will not be available to DPS middle schoolers.

Q: If my child is on the in-person path and is sick, can they do school at home?

A: If your child is sick for any reason, we recommend for them to stay home. They can still log into Schoology and complete missing work, however they will not be able to engage in synchronous/live instruction.
